For 10 Point Questions

9–10	Excellent (no room for improvement)
6–8	Good (clear, interest-catching, relevant)
3–5	Okay (required input from presenter or effort from audience to fully understand)
0–2	Needs Work

For 20 Point Questions

16–20	Excellent (best I've ever seen! Take this to nationals!)
11–15	Good (clear, coherent, well presented)
6–10	Okay (required input from presenter or effort from audience to fully understand)
0–5	Needs Work
