#### • Committee Updates

- Education Committee (Chair Randy Beckwith)
  - FPC2022 nature-like fishway symposium (RLF)
    - □ 7 talks all were solicited, but no additional talks were received.
    - Organizing Committee had a meeting with Steve Malick, who was fine with the talks received, was hoping for more but overall excited.
    - Tim Brush is leading another NLF session at FPC and agreed to combined with our session to create a single day.
    - Plan to have final planning meeting and hope to hear soon about which day the session will be held.
  - AFS2022 bioengineering symposium
    - 17 in-person talks and one virtual which result into 4 blocks over 2 days (2 blocks/day)
    - All talks receive were accepted to the session and the committee has organized the order within the AFS system.

- There will be an opening slot for a welcome /intro to BES and one slot at the end of each day.
- One virtual talk has been accepted (not part of the 17) that will be recorded and available for viewing. The committee hopes to get the speaker virtually/on call for panel discussion second day if schedules and time zone challenges can be overcome.
- Technology Committee
  - No updates
  - Dan will work with Tim Hogan on connecting with the Genetic and Fish Technology and Communication Sections about developing a greater Fisheries Technology Committee.
- AFS-BES/ASCE-EWRI Joint Committee on Fisheries Engineering and Science (Chair Kevin Mulligan)
  - AFS to distribute information on the May 26<sup>th</sup> Infrastructure Bill Webinar in the next e-newsletter and via AFS social media.
- *Resource Policy Committee (Liaison Patrick O'Rouke)* 
  - AFS is still very much pushing the Recovering America's Wildlife Act (RAWA)
  - Infrastructure bill is likely to be a front burner item for AFS engagement and focus, potentially for multiple years.
    - It was noted that there are talks of Federal efforts on how to coordinated bill funding at a watershed level but little know on what this will look like.
  - Back in April Dan, Patrick and Marcin Whitman attended AFS planning meeting on Infrastructure Plenary and Workshop for the AFS Annual Meeting.
    - Patrick is part of the Plenary Session (morning) planning and
    - Dan and Marcin are part of the Workshop (afternoon) planning.
    - Plenary Session planning meetings have discussed potentially getting Federal Senior Staffer to talk on the intent of the bill and identifying another individual to speak on implementation at the ground level.
