

Secretary/Treasurer's Report

Finances

Attached is a statement summarizing the financial activities of the Fisheries Information and Technology Section (FITS) of the American Fisheries Society for the period January 1, 2020-December 31, 2020 as compared to the previous year. Additionally, an updated cash flow statement covering the current year (January 1, 2021 – July 31, 2021) is attached.

In summary, in 2020 we had a increase from our account balances of \$5,318. Much of this increase is due to software sales. Due to the shift to on-line software sales in August 2010 and concurrent shift to annual reimbursement for these sales, the 2020 income figure represents those sales occurring January 1-December 31, 2019. See software report (attached) for trends in software sales. So far in 2021 we have a net balance increase of \$2,824.

Because our section does not have average annual gross receipts of more than \$50,000 over the last 3 years we are no longer required to file IRS Form 990 (Return of Organization Exempt from Income Tax). Instead we were able to file the much simpler IRS Form 990-N which is an electronic postcard. This tax form only requires us to acknowledge that our gross receipts are normally \$50,000 or less. This form was filed in April 2021.

Software Distribution

FITS continues with the following agreements in place for software distribution:

- Ball State University FishBC.
- Jeff Slipke Slipke's Fishery Analysis Tools (aka, S-FAT, a suite of add-on tools for FAST).
- Jeff Slipke Fishery Analysis and Modeling Simulator (FAMS) for 32 bit and 64 bit systems.
- Texas Parks and Wildlife Age and Growth DVD.

Currently, FAMS (both 32 bit and 64 bit), S-FAT, and FishBC, are available exclusively through the AFS Bookstore. Only the Age & Growth DVD continues to be sold through the Secretary/Treasurer although no copies of this have been sold in the past five years.

On October 30, 2014, the Section began offering a FAMS version that runs on 64-bit operating systems and Windows 7, 2010, and 2013. Completion of this was made possible by a \$25,000 loan from the PEF loan. The Section has now repaid the loan in full (\$25,000 principle and \$214.12 interest). All sales occurring in the future will generate revenue for FITS. As a reminder, FITS members have affirmed at several points in the past that software sales should be close to "revenue neutral," providing a service to the profession rather than a profit center for FITS. We expect that to be the case for FAMS.

Membership

As of October 2021, AFS records indicate that FITS membership stands at 489 individuals. This is an increase of 45 from the 2020 membership, driven mostly by increase in student and young professional members and a slight decrease (~8) in regular/retired members.

Executive Committee Meetings

The Section Executive Committee has met via teleconference approximately every month. Summary notes of these calls are available to Section members on the website. A summary of the some of the major topics of discussion is below:

Registration Lottery- This year to help our members through these unprecedented times, FITS held a registration lottery to cover the (early bird rate) registration of 10 lucky student or early Career FITS members to the AFS annual meeting in Baltimore (or virtual). Winners were drawn at random and given a chance to accept the award. We are pleased to help 4 student/early career FITS members attend the AFS 2021 meeting whether in-person or virtual. Giveaways contribute to recruitment and retention, are a way to give back to members, and help us to remain revenue neutral.

Membership Drive- Last December, FITS held a FITS membership renewal giveaway for 20 lucky members. Winners were drawn at random and given a free FITS membership for the 2021 year. The ExCom plans to continue this annual giveaway. Look for the announcement in December!

By-Law Change- Over the past year, our membership voted in favor to update the by-laws to better outline the duties of the President-Elect and Past-President officer positions. Center for Fisheries Technology and Collaboration (CFTC): FITS has been working with AFS to develop the CFTC online platform over the past year. This "Amazon-like" platform will allow vendors to connect with AFS members. AFS members benefit from being able to easily search for tech that they need. Partnership Travel Award Program: The Partnership Travel Award is provided up to twice annually (once/six-month period) to deserving FITS members who wish to represent the section at another society's meetings. The award is meant to encourage networking with groups associated with fisheries science and with AFS, to share knowledge and exchange ideas. The award covers up to \$1,000 in travel expenses and may be used to cover airfare/driving expenses, meals, registration, and lodging. The current award round will be open until February 28, 2022, with an award decision by March 31, for meetings held between May 1 and October 31, 2022.

AFS 2021:

Symposia- This year Tiffany, our president elect, has coordinated a FITS-sponsored symposium at the Baltimore meeting titled "Shifting angler dynamics in relation to the

COVID-19 Pandemic." The symposium will have a hybrid format with both in-person and remote presenters and is currently scheduled to have 8 presentations covering a wide variety of geographic areas in the US and Canada. Talks will discuss data collected in a variety of ways about changes to angler behavior during the past 18 months along with ideas for retaining these anglers.

CE workshops- Due to popular demand, FITS was to sponsor a Data Management continuing education workshop at the 2021 meeting. Unfortunately, we had to postpone this workshop due to covid.

Future Efforts:

Volunteer Opportunities- The ExCom is continuous looking for and creating opportunities for our membership to get involved through numerous opportunities such as volunteering with CFTC. Keep a look out on our website and newsletter for more opportunities to get involved.

Housing for Fisheries-related R Code- We are excited to begin developing a partnership with Derek Ogle and Jason Doll to provide a home for the maintenance and development of fisheries-related R code.
