SUBJECT: Annual Trout Committee Meeting and Workshop

Enclosed is the itinerary for the annual Trout Committee Workshop meeting to be held the 26th through the 29th of June.

The meeting is to be held at Clayton, Georgia. Clayton is located in the extreme northeastern portion of the state.

The program should contain subjects of vital concern to all trout management biologists. Mr. Donald L. Robey, hydraulic engineer with the Ohio River Division of the Corps of Engineers, will present design criteria for selective withdrawal outlets. This will be of value to all of us that have the problem of flood retention structures on trout water.

Mr. Horace Hudson of the University of Georgia will present a program on the economics of trout catch-out ponds. We are experiencing acceleration of this type development in Georgia and this may apply to other states as well. It is something that can no longer be over-looked.

I am requesting that each member present a short informal discussion of trout management or research activities within their agency that would be of value to other members. I am also requesting that you provide an abstract of your presentation sometime during the meeting. These will then be reproduced and distributed to all members and other interested persons. I think this information exchange among member agencies could be one of the most valuable activities of the committee.
